



Financial Aid Policy

A founding purpose of The First Tee is to make golf more accessible to people of all diversities and social strata, particularly young people who otherwise may not have an opportunity to learn and play the game. That is why our policy is to provide access to programs regardless of a participant's ability to pay. Our financial aid program is funded by generous donors and sponsors.

The First Tee of Connecticut provides financial assistance for families who cannot afford the full cost of our programs or events. Parents/guardians apply for financial aid as part of the online registration process.

Eligibility and amount of financial aid are determined by our chapter based on answers to the following online questions:

- How many people are in your household?
- What is your household income range?
- Is the participant receiving free or reduced cost school lunch?
- Is the family experiencing financial hardship?
- How much are you able to pay (if any)?

When you apply for financial aid, the online registration is paused and cannot be completed until the chapter makes a financial aid decision. The chapter might contact the parent/guardian to inquire further about the circumstances before making a decision. Once a decision is made, the chapter will email the parent/guardian that registration can be completed.
